In-service Skills' Enhancement Programme (ISEP)

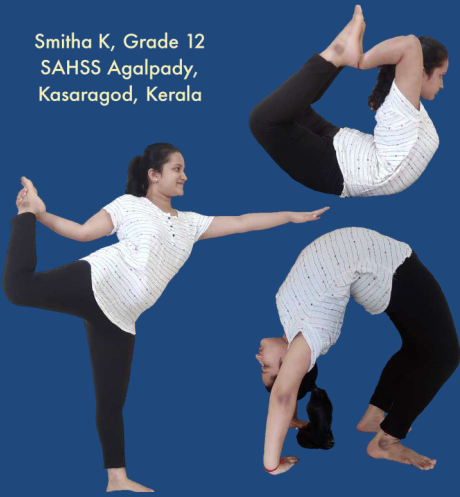
Yoga for Life: International Day of Yoga

Yoga, the pristine technique invented by the ancient saints of India to discover and realise God within.

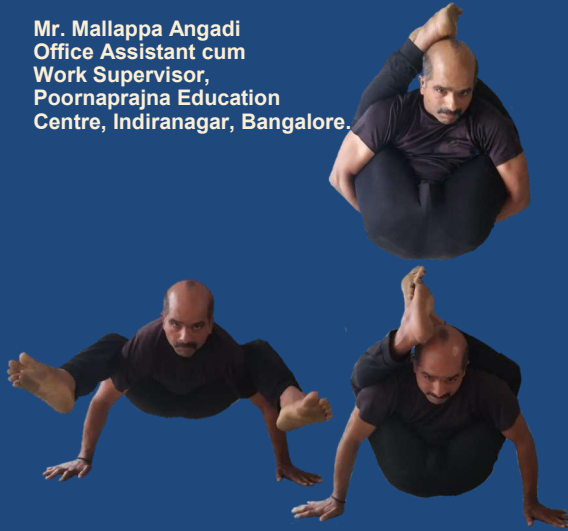
